### GRAPE TREADING CEREMONY

Concert by Marina Carmona in Plaza de la Asuncion - 9.30pm

The Grape Treading Ceremony is the official event that signals the beginning of the Harvest Festival. This festive cycle is one of the most important and prestigious of the city and deeply rooted within all its citizens. Although the wine industry and its prestigious products are the main focus of the festival, it also incorporates other symbols of Jerez's identity, blending traditions, customs, and culture in all their forms, allowing for a full appreciation of the region's unique character and of its people.

The ceremony reenacts the beginning of the wine production process: the arrival of the grape at the press, where the traditional task of treading the grape clusters is repeated over and over to produce the slow extraction of the juice from the fruit and thus the first must after the harvest flows from the press, accompanied by rhythmic musical chords.
